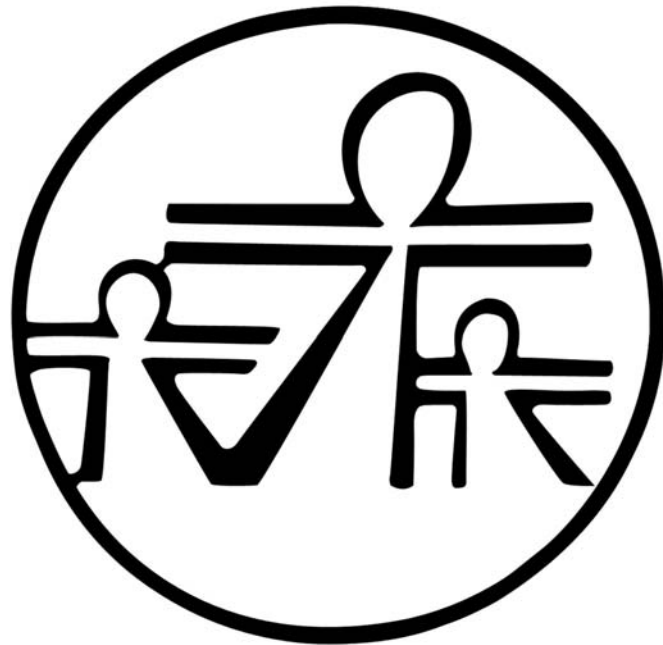

BELONGING TO THE HOLY FAMILY COMMUNITY

Families that choose to join the Holy Family community are committing to the philosophy of shared responsibility in the education of their child. It is a partnership between the parents and the school that supports the development of the whole child. Father Matthew Stanley, our pastor, states, "One of the most vibrant and exciting ministries at Holy Family is our school. What makes our parish school so special is that it is a community in the truest sense of the word - a place where our young people can gather to learn and experience our common faith and tradition as believers in Jesus Christ." Research has shown that children whose parents are involved in their child's education do better in the academic environment. In understanding this philosophy, we have instituted several programs and activities to encourage our parental involvement. Below is a list of these activities and a brief description of the expectation for participation. A more detailed discussion will occur at the New Parent's Orientation in April.

Tuition

As a private Catholic educational institution, our operating budget is funded solely by tuition payments made by parents and fundraising activities throughout the year. Tuition for the school year is based on teacher and staff salaries, and other educational costs. Tuition may be paid monthly or yearly. A tuition schedule is handed out yearly, along with a tuition agreement. In order to receive the Holy Family Parish tuition discount, a Parish Affiliation form must be on file. To qualify, a family must be a registered member of Holy Family Parish for at least six months, use weekly Sunday envelopes and participate in parish activities.

Service Hours

Each family has an obligation to complete 40 hours of service each year. Single parent families are required to fulfill 20 hours. The purpose of this program is for all school parents to participate as volunteers in the activities of the school and/or parish. Activities include, but are not limited to, teacher aide, board member, field trip driver, working at festival, etc. A list of opportunities is sent home at the beginning of the school year, and may be found on our web site. In order to volunteer at Holy Family School, fingerprints must be on file in the school office.

Scrip Commitment

Each family is expected to purchase 4,000.00 of Scrip per school year to help offset operating budget expenses. This amount must be reached by the end of April 2010. Our list of Scrip participants is extensive to help all families meet this commitment.

PTG Fundraising Participation

Our Parent-Teacher Group (PTG) sponsors several major fundraisers each year. These fundraisers currently are: Reader's Digest or QSP Wrapping Paper and See's Candy in the fall and Jog-A-Thon in the spring. PTG is also involved with the Annual Golf Tournament and Enchanted Evening Dinner/Dance Auction. All of the money raised goes to support the operating budget of the school, or specific projects that are not covered by the school budget. All families are required to participate in and support these events.

School Development

Tuition pays the majority of costs for educating our children, but not all of them. The shortfall is covered by fundraisers. Our "The Gifting of Faith" appeal will be used to fund our long-range plan which includes technology upgrades, and other needed improvements (last year we were able to raise over \$200,000 for the school). This is a tax-deductible way to help support the school. We ask our families to support this appeal based on their financial capabilities.

Faculty: All teachers are college graduates with full teaching credentials, many have advanced degrees.

Core Program: Religion, Mathematics, Language Arts (Reading, Phonics, English, Spelling, Handwriting), Natural Sciences and Social Sciences. Algebra (offered to qualified 7th and 8th grade students).

Weekly: Music, Physical Education, Library, Computer, Art and Spanish (currently available for our qualified 8th grade students).

Religious Formation and Activities: The school day starts with a school wide prayer. There are also monthly liturgies, prayer services, sacramental preparation, seasonal spiritual activities and retreat opportunities

Extra Curricular Activities: Academic Chess Club, Community Outreach, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, National Junior Honor Society, Student Council, Lego Robotics, Schmahl Hands-on Science labs, Homework Club, Spanish (for Kindergarten-4th grade students), Newspaper Club and California Junior Scholarship Federation.

Sports: Basketball, Volleyball, Track, Softball (Girls), and Flag Football (Boys) for students in 5th-8th grades.

Student Services: Extended Care – 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Learning Assistance Program for students in K-3rd grades.

Parent Involvement: Parents are required to volunteer 40 hours per year for a two-parent family, 20 hours for a single parent. A \$4,000.00 yearly family purchase of Scrip (gift cards) and support of our fundraisers is also required.

Current Registration: Registration fees, after acceptance, are \$400.00 per child (non-refundable).

To receive the parish support rate, a family must fill out a parish affiliation form and meet the following requirements:

1. Be registered in Holy Family Parish. All families wishing to be considered for “in parish” rate must be a consistent member for at least 6 months and have a Parish Affiliation Form approved by the parish office.
2. Attend Mass regularly at Holy Family parish.
3. Contribute in a consistent manner to support of the parish by means of numbered donation envelopes for a minimum period of six months. The use of these envelopes is recorded weekly in a confidential manner by the parish staff.
4. Participate in parish activities.

Holy Family School admits students of any race, color, national, and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national, or ethnic origin in the administration of educational policies, admissions policies, scholarships and loan programs, or athletic and other school programs.

HOLY FAMILY SCHOOL APPLICATION INFORMATION AND ADMISSION POLICY

All students interested in applying to Holy Family School must meet the following age criteria:

Kindergarten - age 5 by September 1, 2009
First Grade - age 6 by September 1, 2009

*Exceptions may be considered and must be based on specific criteria of readiness and performance. The decision will be made only after consultation with the parents, teacher, and Principal.

When selecting students for admission to Holy Family School, preference is given in the following order:

- Siblings of current Holy Family School students
- Registered, active Holy Family Parishioners
- Registered, active Catholics of another parish
- Catholics who are either not registered, non-participating, or non-supporting members of a Catholic parish
- Non-Catholics

Grade Readiness Testing

Holy Family School tests every applicant for grade readiness. Grade Readiness testing will be held on Wednesday, February 11, 2009 between 1:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. for our Kindergarten applicants and on Wednesday, March 11, 2009 for our 1st-7th grade applicants. The test consists of age-appropriate evaluation for the younger grades and age-appropriate curriculum review for the upper grades. You must have a completed application on file by January 30, 2009 for Kindergarten, and by February 13, 2009 for 1st-7th grade to attend testing.

Completed Application Consists of the Following:

1. Application Fee - \$60.00 (Non-refundable)
2. Copy of County Birth Certificate (not a hospital copy)
3. Copy of Baptismal Certificate (if baptized)
4. Preschool evaluation or progress report (if applicable)
5. Copies of the previous two years Report Cards (1st-7th grade)
6. Copies of all Standardized Test Scores (1st-7th grade)
7. Current Teacher Recommendation Form (all grades)
8. Copies of Immunization Records (all grades)
9. Completed Application turned in no later than Jan. 30, 2009 (Kindergarten) and Feb. 13, 2009 (1st-7th grade)

Return your application to Sheryl Citta, Admissions Director. Testing times will not be scheduled until your application is complete.

Acceptance Procedure:

Acceptance information is not available by phone. All letters will be sent by Feb. 25, 2009 for Kindergarten and Mar. 23, 2009 for grades 1st-7th. All registration forms and a non-refundable registration fee of \$400.00 are due by March 13, 2009 for Kindergarten and April 1, 2009 for grades 1st-7th.
